

# Autumn 2 in Class 3



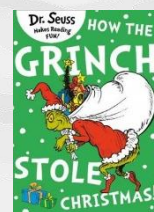
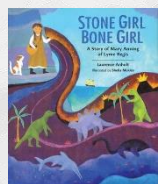
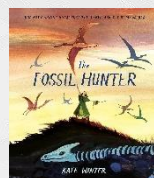
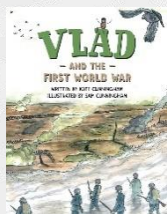
## Reading & Literacy
