

# Spring One in Class 2

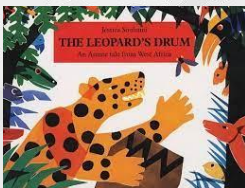
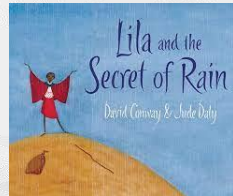
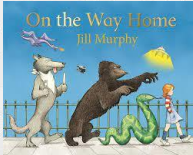


## English

England or Kenya?**



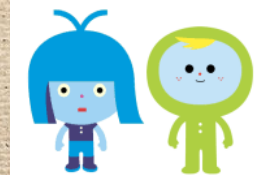
## RE & PSCH

### RE

What does it mean to belong to Christianity? Children will learn about baptism and how this demonstrates a commitment to God and the belonging to a Christian church.

### Happy Schools

Children will be discussing positive relationships.





## Science

Our challenge question this term is...

What would Traction Man use to build our school?

This question will allow children to explore everyday materials. Children will use their observation and investigation skills to explore everyday materials and their properties.



## Art

What does the African Savannah look like?

Children will explore African landscapes by a range of artists. They will create their own collage and textile Savannah landscape painting; developing a wide range of art and design techniques in using colour, pattern, texture, line, shape, form and space.



## PE

Children have PE sessions twice a week. On a Monday afternoon with a coach. On a Friday afternoon the children will cover dance through a unit linked to a starry night.

## Music

The children will be listening and appraising songs looking at pulse rhythm and pitch. They will learn to sing the songs linked to friendship practicing the verses, chorus and the bridge.
