

Autumn One in Class 2

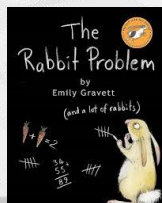
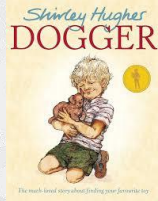
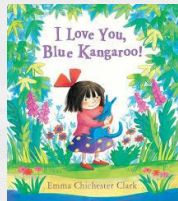


English

This half term we will continue with the 'Success for All' programme to develop our reading skills. Those children still working on their phonics will learn new letters & sounds each week. Children who have completed this will work through our spelling program. Please continue to read with your child at home to help them become a fluent reader and earn reading stars. In writing children will be focusing on letter writing and writing their own narrative.

Maths

This term, children will start their Maths journey in Class 2. They will learn through the use of concrete equipment to embed the following concepts:

- Place value within 20
- Addition and Subtraction within 20.

Science

Our challenge question this term is...

'Why are there so many leaves on the floor?'

This question will allow children to explore seasonal changes. They will describe weather in the different seasons and comment on the length of the day.

History

This term we will be looking at Toys from the past through the challenge question...

Are I pads more fun than your grandparents' toys?

Children will learn the toys their grandparents played with were different to their own and learn about main differences between their school days and that of their grandparents.



Reading

Home Reading – Reading books will come home on a Friday and should be returned on a Wednesday. Please read with your child as frequently as possible and write a little comment in their yellow reading record log. Each time your child reads at home they will receive a star and become a bronze, silver and then a gold reader. Once they have received gold level they will receive a raffle tickets. At the end of a term we will draw the tickets and children will receive a reading reward

Art

How can you create patterns using leaves in the style of William Morris?



Children will create a repeating pattern in print, creating a piece of art in response to the work of another artist.

PE

Children have PE sessions twice a week. They will normally be on a Tuesday and a Friday.

We will continue to provide children with a PE in school. If children could bring a set of trainers or plimsolls into school.

Music

Hey, You!

The children will be listening and appraising songs looking at pulse rhythm and pitch. They will learn to sing the song 'Hey, you!' practicing the verses, chorus and the bridge.



Computing

Year 2 children worked really hard last year learning how to log onto our Class laptops using their own personal logins and are confident using our Purple Mash learning computing programme. Year 1 children will be introduced to this programme.

Children will use our laptops to access learning in Maths through numbots, freckle and ttrackstars.

Logins will be sent home over the next couple of weeks.
