

Spring One in Class 2

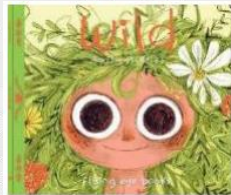


English

Why is Jesus special to Christians?

Children will learn why Jesus is important to Christians.

Happy Schools

Children will be discussing: Positive relationships.

Science

Our challenge question this term is...

Why would a dinosaur not make a good pet?

Children will explore and compare differences between things that are living, dead and things that have never been alive. They will identify that most living things live in habitats to which they are suited and describe how different habitats provide for the basic needs of different kinds of animals and plants, and how they depend on each other.



Art

What do we mean by hot and cold colours?

Through this challenge question the children will explore mixing colours and making tints. They will look at artwork from artist, such as; Piet Mondrian, Mark Rothko, Paul Klee, Jackson Pollock, Robert and Sonia Delaunay and Wassily Kandinsky. They will use their knowledge to apply this to their own artwork.

PE

Children have PE sessions twice a week. This term they will have PE on a Monday afternoon with the PE coaches. Our other PE sessions will focus on dance. This will be linked to the seasons.

Music

Hands, Feet and Heart

The children will be listening and appraising songs looking at pulse rhythm and pitch. They will learn to sing the song 'Hands, Feet and Heart' practicing the verses, chorus and the bridge.



Computing

Children will learn how to log onto our Class laptops using their own personal logins. Our Purple Mash learning this term will:

- Online Safety and Exploring
- Lego builders
- Grouping and sorting
- Technology outside the home.

Children will learn to use our laptops to access learning in Maths through numbots, freckle and ttrackstars.
