

Summer One in Class 2

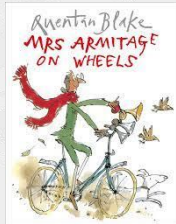


English

Books and stories that we will focus on this term are



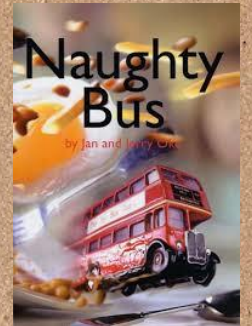
Maths

In maths this term, we will begin by learning about money before moving on to fractions. Year 2 children will continue to practise their 2, 5, and 10 times tables, while Year 1 children will focus on developing their understanding of doubling and halving.

History

Where do and did the wheels on the bus go?

Children will hop on board an exciting adventure with our *Travel and Transport* topic! We'll explore all kinds of journeys; comparing how people travel today with how they travelled in the past.

Science

Our challenge question this term is...

'Which birds, animal and plants would you find in our local woods?'

Children will learn to identify and name a variety of common, wild and green plants, including deciduous and evergreen tree. They will identify and describe the basic structure of a variety of common flowering plants, including trees. Children will also learn about the different birds they will see in their local area.

Art

What's that creepy Crawly Creature?

Through our art question we will explore all things Crawly in our school garden. Children will draw simple sketches and bring them to life by making 3D sculptures using clay. Children will learn how to manipulate clay in different ways.



PE

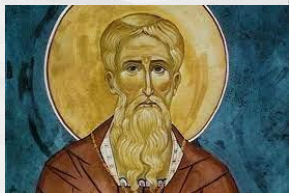
Children have PE sessions twice a week, on Wednesdays and Fridays.

Religious Education
